

Registration Agreement and Studio Policies

The fall recital will be Dec 13th & 14th. Dancers are expected to participate in the recital at the end of the semester. A majority of the semester is spent on recital choreography and prep so if you will not be available for the recital please let us know before the season begins. Auditorium rehearsals will be Dec 8th - 12th and are *required* for recital participation so make sure you will be here for the entire week. These rehearsals are not at the same time as our studio classes. The schedule will be sent out a few weeks prior to recital week

Dancers may not have more than 3 unexcused absences to be able to participate in the recital. (*this is 25% percent of the semester's classes*) Please let the teacher know if your dancer will be absent for any reason

-*Excused* absences include illness, family emergency, etc.

-*Unexcused* absences include vacations, not showing up for class, another activity/sports related trip, etc.

Dancers are expected to come dressed in appropriate dancewear for every class per our studio dress code. This includes the correct shoes, clothes, and hair pulled up and away from the face. Please review it on the next page before signing below.

Tuition does not include recital costumes, these range from \$40 - \$80 per class and include performance tights and accessories. There will be a costume pick up day the weekend before the recital where you pay and pick up all costumes at the studio.

We use the Band app exclusively to communicate between teachers and parents/guardians. After registration you will be placed in the appropriate class(es) and the teacher will use the app to communicate class info, recital details, and schedule changes. Please make sure you have this downloaded at the beginning of the semester so you don't miss important information.

We use 1-2-3 Magic in class as a management tool. Parents will be notified when a 3 (sit out) has been given to their child. When a student sits out three times in total, we will call a meeting with the parent to discuss the child's behavior.

Dancers are expected to be dressed in appropriate dancewear at every class

Ballet:

Black leotard, ballet pink or skin toned tights (convertible for pre pointe and pointe), pink ballet slippers

Dance wrap sweater, fitted black shorts, colored ballet skirt optional.

Jazz:

Black leotard, ballet pink, skin toned or black tights, skin toned jazz shoes

Dance skirt, black jazz pants or black shorts optional.

Boys in all dance styles:

White shirt, black dance pants, ballet shoes or skin toned jazz shoes

Tot and Kinder Classes:

Tot and kinder class should follow the above for ballet or boys styles

Combo Class:

Combo classes should follow the above for ballet or boys styles

Dance Team:

Jazz attire and half sole shoes/dance paws
