

## **Mitkof Dance Troupe (MDT) Mitigation Plan Bullet Points 2021 SUMMER SESSION**

***MDT MISSION STATEMENT:** The Mitkof Dance Troupe (MDT) strives to empower individuals in body and mind through dance education and creative movement. We inspire community wellness and the continued development of performing arts in Petersburg. MDT is a non-profit educational and charitable organization open to all individuals.*

Your teachers and MDT are committed to providing the Petersburg community a positive environment for dance education. As a nonprofit organization, we strive to offer each student:

- High-quality dance education experience
- A welcoming atmosphere for dancers, parents, and families
  - Clean and safe facility
- Exposure to many styles of dance and movement

### **Criteria for all students, teachers, staff, board members and volunteers participating in MDT-affiliated activities while indoor on MDT premises at Episcopal Church or New MDT Building:**

- **Facial coverings**
  - Facial covering will be required for all students and staff
- **Liability Waivers**
  - Signed and recorded liability waiver for every in-person participant, including instructors, board members and teachers. This waiver must be signed and kept on file by the instructor with the ability to provide MDT a copy of the waiver at any time.
- **Safety Requirements**
  - Participants and/or teachers must agree not to participate in indoor classes or meetings if they:
    - Are exhibiting the current CDC recognized symptoms consistent with COVID-19;
    - Have knowingly been in contact with a suspected or positive case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days;
    - Are within **72 hours** of exhibiting significant COVID-19 symptoms or a fever; after that time symptom-free, the participant and/or teacher can return to class;
    - When recovering from a case of COVID-19, are less than 14 days from onset or less than 72 hours since the end of significant symptoms or fever;

- Have traveled out of the Petersburg Borough within the last 14 days. Time may be reduced to return to classes if participant or instructor has received a second negative Covid test, 5 or more days post arrival back to Petersburg Borough.
  - Clearance note from doctor to return to activity if participant and/or teacher has had COVID-19;
  - No one will be allowed to enter premises if an individual or household member is waiting on results from symptomatic pending Covid test
- **Restrooms** are open, but limited to one individual at a time; please come dressed for class
- **Hand washing** or **Sanitizing** is mandatory upon entering facility
- **Lobby**
  - Limited to screening process only
- **Kitchen** is closed for the foreseeable future and used only if a participant or teacher exhibits symptoms and needs to be isolated until transport arrives
- **Cleaning, Disinfecting, and Ventilation**
  - Classes will be scheduled with 15 minutes between each class to provide time for cleaning, screening, and previous classes to be clear of the space
  - Frequently-touched surfaces are cleaned after every use, including after every indoor teacher planning or virtual sessions, with or without students.
  - Floors are mopped and sanitized, as needed, based on usage throughout the week.
  - Ventilation systems are operational in each inside studio
- **Assessment of students per class**
  - Clearly marked spaces; the maximum number of participants per class will be 12 with 1 instructor; no more than 13 persons in the studio will be permitted

**\*\*\*All teachers, staff, volunteers and students will be required to follow ALL mitigation procedures whenever inside the building with students or fellow teachers. MDT Mitigation plans for outdoor classes must also be followed when teachers and students are engaging in any MDT affiliated student/teacher or teacher/teacher training, classes or practices both on and off site. Failure to comply with mitigation protocols will result in temporary termination of classes until further notice.\*\*\***
